PROJECT OVERVIEW

Deep in the heart of the Appalachian Mountains a new gaming destination was rising. Harrah's Casino was building a new casino and hotel near Murphy, NC. When finished, the facility will feature 60,000 square feet of gaming space and a 300-room hotel.



PROJECT DETAILS

The architects designed the structure using hollow core planks. While a popular method of construction because of fast building assembly and lower weight, it requires a self-leveling cement to be poured over the top that will provide a hard, durable and level surface for the substrate.
